Dear Ms Gomes,

Thank you for your letter of the 25th May.

As you are aware, I met previously with the official European Parliament Delegation to Malta and cooperated fully with their visit in November and December 2017. I can reassure you that Malta Police are respectful of the work undertaken in that important institution.

I understand though that your current , private, delegation has no official mandate from the European Parliament. Unlike your previous visit which involved a much larger group, you are not representing a Parliament Committee or Committee of Inquiry. This is instead a political visit.

The official delegation had a mandate, sending a group of MEP's with a balanced representation, to establish facts, and without interfering with on going criminal investigations. Your letter indicates that for your private Delegation this is not the case.

As such it would be inappropriate for me to accept your request for a meeting.

I, and the Malta Police, remain at the complete disposal of any official delegation of the European Parliament should they wish to follow up on the previous official visit.
