TEXT:

The Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf (GCC) – EU Joint Council and Ministerial Meeting held on 24th May stated that "Ministers looked forward to further cooperation in (...) human rights". Furthermore, the European External Action Service (EEAS) stated on 28th May to the members of the Arab Peninsula Delegation of the European Parliament that a working group on human rights was under way, without giving any further details. However, the European Parliament was not informed and remains unaware to date on the nature and content of the EU-GCC human rights working groups.

- To "further cooperation in human rights" does the High Representative intend to discuss this issue at ministerial level, given that in creating human rights working groups at a technical level, ministerial meetings are able to avoid discussing human rights altogether?




