Dear Mr. O'Sullivan,

I would like to, once again, bring to your attention the case of Mr. Ahmed Abdi Adam, a Somali refugee stationed in Yemen, who has already been in contact with UNHCR - Yemen.

He has reported to me that UNHCR employees keep asking him to pay for his relocation to a third country, as he stated before and as I informed you. In your last e-mail, from 29 September, you said that no UNHCR employee has asked him to pay any fee, however this is contrary to what he has again reported to me: he has been told that he either pays or risks walking to Egypt. He even gave me the names of the UNHCR employees in question, names that I will keep to myself in order not to put Mr. Adam's life in risk. I must tell you that he is fearing for his life. And the fact is that, despite all the efforts he and I have done, he has yet to be relocated!

This is of the utmost gravity and UNHCR needs to immediately investigate these claims and its field employees in the camp in Yemen. I urge you to take the necessary steps so that Mr. Ahmed Abdi Adam is finally relocated, as well as his suffering mother who is still stranded in the Dollo Ado refugee camp in Ethiopia. She is in need of medical treatment.

I really request your help in these two humani-  
tarian cases.
